col.Petrol approximately 100g / 400m

NEEDLES

3.3mm / JP4 circular needle

3.9mm / JP6 circular needle

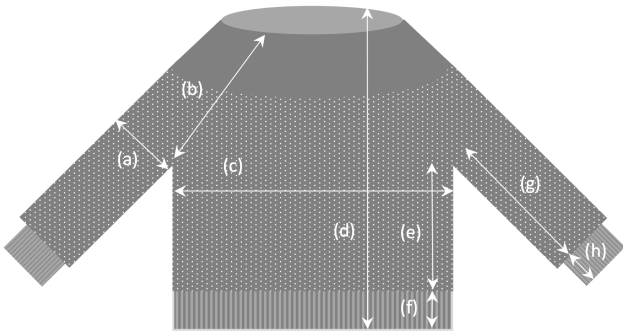
GAUGE

21 sts and 40 rows = 10cm
In Brioche pattern ([🔗 Chart](#)) with 3.9mm / JP6 needle

SEC. 1: NECK

Use **3.3mm / JP4** circular needle and **MC**

R1: CO126, PM for BOR, Join to work in the round

> BOR is at the back of the right sleeve

R2: SM, [P1, Sl1] to M

R3: SM, [P1, K1 tbl] to M

R4-9: [R2-3] 3 times

R10: SM, P to M

SEC. 2: YOKE

Change to **3.9mm / JP6** circular needle

Set Up: SM, K to M

Start German Short Rows

SR1(RS): SM, [K1, Sl1yo] 5 times, K1, Turn

SR2(WS): MDS, [Brp1, P1] to M, SM, [Sl1yo, P1] 25 times, Turn

SR3(RS): MDS, [Brk1, K1] to 1 st bef M, Brk1, SM,
[Sl1yo, K1] to DS, KDS, [K1, Sl1yo] 2 times, K1, Turn

SR4(WS): MDS, [Brp1, P1] 2 times, P1, [P1, Brp1] to M, SM,

[P1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef DS, P1, PDS,

[P1, Sl1yo] 2 times, P1, Turn

SR5(RS): MDS, [Brk1, K1] 2 times, K1, [K1, Brk1] to 1 st bef M,

K1, SM, [K1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef DS, K1, KDS,

[K1, Sl1yo] 2 times, K1, Turn

SR6(WS): MDS, [Brp1, P1] 2 times, P1, [P1, Brp1] to 1 st bef M,

P1, SM, [Sl1yo, P1] to DS, PDS, [P1, Sl1yo] 2 times,

P1, Turn

SR7(RS): MDS, [Brk1, K1] 2 times, K1, [K1, Brk1] to M, SM,

[Sl1yo, K1] to DS, KDS, [K1, Sl1yo] 2 times, K1, Turn

SR8-10: SR4-6

SR11(RS): MDS, [Brk1, K1] 2 times, K1, [K1, Brk1] to M

End German Short Rows

R1: SM, [Sl1yo, K1] to DS, KDS, [K1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef DS,

K1, KDS, [K1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef M, K1

R2: SM, [Brk1, K1] 15 times, K1, [K1, Brk1] 12 times, K3,

[Brk1, K1] to M

R3: SM, [K1, Sl1yo] to M

R4: SM, [K1, Brk1] to M

R5: SM, [Sl1yo, K1] to M

R6: SM, [Brk1, K1] to M

R7-14: [R3-6] 2 times

R15: SM, P to M

R16: SM, [K2, Kfb] to M

> 42 sts inc, 168 sts in total

Join **CC** and Start **Chart**

R17-31: SM, [Chart] to M

R32(MC): SM, [K3, Kfb] to M

> 42 sts inc, 210 sts in total

R33-47: SM, [Chart] to M

R48(MC): SM, [K4, Kfb] to M

> 42 sts inc, 252 sts in total

R49-63: SM, [Chart] to M

R64(MC): SM, [K5, Kfb] to M

> 42 sts inc, 294 sts in total

R65-79: SM, [Chart] to M

SEC.3: BODY

Separate Sleeves and Body

Set Up: SM, Place 56 sleeve stitches on a holder, CO10, K6,

[Kfb, K5] 14 times, K1,

Place 56 sleeve stitches on a holder, CO10, K6,

[Kfb, K5] 14 times, K1
> 230 sts in total for body

R1-15: SM, [Chart] to M

R16(MC): SM, K to M

R17-96: [R1-16] 5 times

Break CC

SEC. 4: HEM

R1: SM, [P1, Sl1] to M

R2: SM, [P1, K1 tbl] to M

R3-34: [R1-2] 16 times

R35: R1

R36: BO all stitches in R2 pattern

SEC. 5: SLEEVES

Use **3.9mm / JP6** circular needle and **MC**

Set Up: Begin at the center of the underarm,
Pick up and knit 5 sts from the underarm,
K56 from a holder, Pick up and knit 5 sts from underarm,
PM for BOR, Join to work in the round
> 66 sts in total

Join CC and Start  [Chart](#)

R1-15: SM, [Chart] to M

R16(MC): SM, K to M

R17-48: [R1-16] 2 times

R49-63: SM, [Chart] to M

R64(MC): SM, K2tog, K to 2 sts bef M, SSK

> 2 sts dec, 64 sts in total

R65-112: [R49-64] 3 times

> 6 sts dec, 58 sts in total

R113-127: SM, [Chart] to M

R128(MC): SM, K to M

Break CC

SEC. 6: CUFFS

R1: SM, [P1, Sl1] to M

R2: SM, [P1, K1 tbl] to M

R3-24: [R1-2] 11 times

R25: R1

R26: BO all stitches in R2 pattern
