Saredo ito - re-specked cotton - [200g / 780m / 100% cotton]

col.S25 MUSTARD approximately 200g / 780m

Contrast Color :

Saredo ito - RECYCLED COTTON 100 - [200g / 780m / 100% cotton]

col.he-1 ササヤマロン approximately 60g / 234m

NEEDLES

3.9mm / JP6 circular needle

3.3mm / JP4 circular needle

2.25mm circular needle

GAUGE

25 sts and 38 rows = 10cm

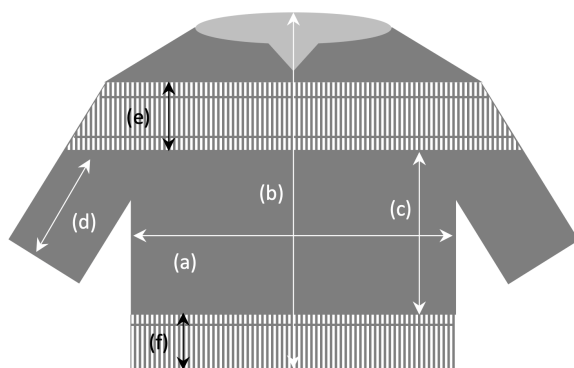
In Stockinette stitch with 3.3mm / JP4 needle

SEC.1: NECK

Use **2.25mm** circular needle and **MC**
Work **flat**

R1: CO116 using Long Tail method

R2(WS): Sl1 wyif, P to E

R3(RS): Sl1 wyib, K to E

R4-9: [R2-3] 3 times

R10(WS): Sl1 wyif, K to 1 st bef E, P1

SEC.2: YOKE

Change to **3.3mm / JP4** circular needle
Start **German Short Rows**

SR1(RS): Sl1 wyib, K105, Turn

SR2(WS): MDS, P95, Turn

SR3(RS): MDS, K to DS, KDS, K2, Turn

SR4(WS): MDS, P to DS, PDS, P2, Turn

SR5-10: [SR3-4] 3 times

SR11(RS): MDS, K to DS, KDS, K to E

SR12(WS): SI1 wyif, P to DS, PDS, P to E

End German Short Rows

Start **Yoke Increases**

R1(RS): SI1 wyib, K to E

R2(WS): SI1 wyif, P to E

Work all **Even number rows (WS)** to **R16** in **R2** pattern

R3(RS): SI1 wyib, [K3, M1L, K3] 19 times, K1

> 19 sts inc, 135 sts in total

R5(RS): SI1 wyib, M1R, K to 1 st bef E, M1L, K1

> 2 sts inc, 137 sts in total

R7(RS): SI1 wyib, K1, [K3, M1L, K4] 19 times, K2

> 19 sts inc, 156 sts in total

R9(RS): R5

> 2 sts inc, 158 sts in total

R11(RS): SI1 wyib, K2, [K4, M1L, K4] 19 times, K3

> 19 sts inc, 177 sts in total

R13(RS): R5

> 2 sts inc, 179 sts in total

R15(RS): SI1 wyib, K3, [K4, M1L, K5] 19 times, K4

> 19 sts inc, 198 sts in total

R17(RS): R5

> 2 sts inc, 200 sts in total

Join Fronts and Work in the round

Continue **Yoke Increases**

R1: PM for BOR, Join to knit in the round, K to M

R2: [M1L, K10], rep [-] to M

> 20 sts inc, 220 sts in total

R3-5: [R1] 3 times

R6: *K6, M1L, [K11, M1L] 4 times, K11, M1R,

[K11, M1R] 4 times, K5*, rep *-*

> 20 sts inc, 240 sts in total

R7-9: [R1] 3 times

R10: *K6, M1L, [K12, M1L] 4 times, K13, M1R,

[K12, M1R] 4 times, K5*, rep *-*

> 20 sts inc, 260 sts in total

R11-13: [R1] 3 times

R14: *K6, M1L, [K13, M1L] 4 times, K15, M1R,

[K13, M1R] 4 times, K5*, rep *-*

> 20 sts inc, 280 sts in total

R15-17: [R1] 3 times

R18: *K6, M1L, [K14, M1L] 4 times, K17, M1R,

[K14, M1R] 4 times, K5*, rep *-*

> 20 sts inc, 300 sts in total

R19-21: [R1] 3 times

R22: *K6, M1L, [K15, M1L] 4 times, K19, M1R,
[K15, M1R] 4 times, K5*, rep *-*

> 20 sts inc, 320 sts in total

R23-25: [R1] 3 times

R26: [M1L, K8], rep [-] to M

> 40 sts inc, 360 sts in total

Break Yarn

Change to **3.9mm / JP6** circular needle

Join **CC** and Start **Color Work**

SetUp: RM, **SI120**, PM for BOR, Join CC

> Move BOR to Left Back

R1(CC): K to M

Join **MC**

R2(MC): [P1, SI1 wyib], rep [-] to M

R3(CC): [P1, K1 tbl], rep [-] to M

R4-5: R2-3

R6(CC): P to M

R7: R6

R8-21: [R2-3] 7 times

R22-23: [R6] 2 times

R24-27: [R2-3] 2 times

R28: R2

R29(MC): [K1, K1 tbl], rep [-] to M

R30(MC): K to M

End Color Work

Break CC

Change to **3.3mm / JP4** circular needle

R1: [K10, M1L], rep [-] to M

> 36 sts inc, 396 sts in total

R2: K to M

SEC. 3: BODY

Separate Sleeves and Body

[K132, Place 66 sleeve stitches on a holder, CO18] 2 times

> 300 sts for Body, 66 sts for each Sleeve

Start Body

Work in **Stockinette stitch** until body measures 20cm from underarm

SEC.4: HEM

Join **CC** and Start **Color Work**

R1(CC): Join CC, K to M

R2(MC): [P1, Sl1 wyib], rep [-] to M

R3(CC): [P1, K1 tbl], rep [-] to M

R4-7: [R2-3] 2 times

End Color Work

Break **MC** and Continue with **CC**

R8: [P8, P2tog], rep [-] to M

> 30 sts dec, 270 sts in total

R9: P to M

R10-35: [R2-3] 13 times

R36: R2

R37: BO all stitches in R3 pattern

SEC.5: SLEEVES

Use **3.3mm / JP4** circular needle and **MC**

Work in the round

SetUp: Begin at the center of underarm,

Pick up and knit 9 sts from underarm,

K66 from a holder, Pick up and knit 9 sts from underarm,

PM for BOR, Join to knit in the round

> 84 sts in total

R1-59: K to M

R60: [K2, K2tog], rep [-] to M

> 21 sts dec, 63 sts in total

I-cord Bind Off

CO5 using cable CO,

[K4, K2tog tbl, Slip 5 sts back to left needle], rep [-] to M,

Join I-cord ends
