color: no.4 black and blue approximately 270g / 630m

NEEDLES

6.0mm/JP13 circular needle

5.1mm/JP10 circular needle

Cable needle

GAUGE

14sts and 20.5rows = 10cm

In Stockinette stitch with 6.0mm/JP13 needle

NOTIONS

Stitch markers

Holders

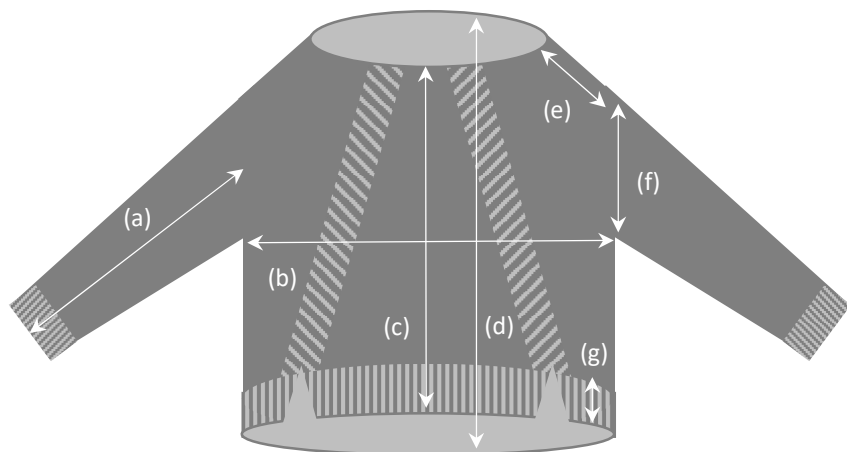
Hachi has cable lines that look like the kanji '八'.

It is first worked in the round, then back and forth separately to the underarm.

They are joined again and worked in the round.

Each sleeve is picked up from each side of the body.

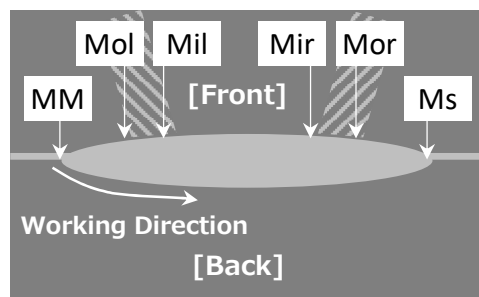

Use **5.1mm/JP10** circular needle

R1: **CO88** using Long Tail method, PMM for BOR, Join to work in the round

R2: SMM, [P1, K1] 20 times, P1, PMs, [K1,P1] 5 times, K1, PMor, [P1, K1, P1, K1, P1] 2 times, PMir, [K1, P1] 2 times, K1, PMil, [P1,K1, P1, K1, P1] 2 times, PMol, [K1, P1] 5 times, K1

>41sts for Back Neck, 47sts for Front Neck

R3: SMM, [P1, K1] to Mor (Slipping Ms), SMor, [P1, K1, P1, K1, P1] 2 times, SMir, [K1, P1] to 1st bef Mil, K1, SMil, [P1, K1, P1, K1, P1] 2 times, SMol, [K1, P1] to 1st bef MM, K1

R4-6: R3

Sec.2: Yoke

Change to **6.0mm/JP13** circular needle

Start **German Short Row (Neck Shaping)** and **Shoulder Increases (every 1 row)**

SR1(RS): SMM, P1, M1L, K to 1st bef Ms, M1R, P1, SMs, K1, P1, M1L, K3, Turn

>3sts inc

SR2(WS): MDS, P to 2sts bef Ms, M1PL, K1, P1,SMs, K1, M1PR, P to 1st bef MM, M1PL, K1, SMM, P1, K1, M1PR, P3, Turn

>4sts inc

SR3(RS): MDS, K to 2sts bef MM, M1R, P1, K1, SMM, P1, M1L, K to 1st bef Ms, M1R, P1, SMs, K1, P1, M1L, K to DS, KDS, K2, Turn

>4sts inc

SR4(WS): MDS, P to 2sts bef Ms, M1PL, K1, P1,SMs, K1, M1PR, P to 1st bef MM, M1PL, K1, SMM, P1, K1, M1PR, P to DS, PDS, P2, Turn

>4sts inc

SR5-8: [SR3-4] 2 times

>16sts inc

SR9(RS): MDS, K to 2sts bef MM, M1R, P1, K1

>1sts inc, 57sts for Back Yoke, 63sts for Front Yoke

End German Short Row, Continue Soulder Increases (every 1 row)

Start **Chart (See page 3)** and **Front Center Increases (every 4 rows)**

R1: SMM, P1, M1L, K to 1st bef Ms, M1R, P1, SMs, K1, P1, M1L, K to Mor (Knitting DS), SMor, Chart R, SMir, K to Mil, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to 2sts bef MM (Knitting DS), M1R, P1, K1

>Start with R1 of Chart R/L, 4sts inc, 59sts for Back Yoke, 65sts for Front Yoke

R2-4: R1

>12sts inc, 65sts for Back Yoke, 71sts for Front Yoke

R5: SMM, P1, M1L, K to 1st bef Ms, M1R, P1, SMs, K1, P1, M1L, K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, M1L, K to Mil, M1R, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to 2sts bef MM, M1R, P1, K1

>6sts inc, 67sts for Back Yoke, 75sts for Front Yoke, 7sts between Mir and Mil

R6-8: R1

>12sts inc, 73sts for Back Yoke, 81sts for Front Yoke

R9-12: R5-8

>End with R12 of Chart R/L, 18sts inc, 81sts for Back Yoke, 91sts for Front Yoke, 9sts between Mir and Mil

End Soulder Increases

Separate Back and Front Yokes and Work Back Yoke in flat

R1(RS): RMM, K to Ms, RMs, Place 91 Front Yoke sts on a holder

>81sts for Back Yoke

R2(WS): P to End

R3(RS): K to End

R4-29: [R2-3] 13 times

R30(WS): R2, Place 81 Back Yoke sts on a holder

Break Yarn

Join Yarn and Work Front Yoke in flat

Continue Chart and Front Center Increases and Start Sides Decreases (every 4 rows)

R1(RS): Place 91 Front Yoke sts on a needle with RS facing, Place 1 Sleeve st on a holder, Join yarn, K1, SSK, K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, M1L, K to Mil, M1R, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to 4sts bef End, K2to, K1, Place 1 Sleeve st on a holder

>Start with R1 of Chart R/L, 89sts for Front Yoke, 11sts between Mir and Mil, 29sts between each End and Mor/Mol

R2(WS): P to Mol, SMol, Chart L, SMil, P to Mir, SMir, Chart R, SMor, P to End

R3(RS): K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, K to Mil, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to End

R4(WS): R2
R5(RS): K1, SSK, K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, M1L, K to Mil, M1R, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to 3sts bef End, K2to, K1
>13sts between Mir and Mil, 28sts between each End and Mor/Mol
R6-8: R2-4
R9-28: [R5-8] 5 times
>23sts between Mir and Mil, 23sts between each End and Mor/Mol
R29(RS): R5
>25sts between Mir and Mil, 22sts between each End and Mor/Mol
R30(WS): R2
>End with R6 of Chart R/L

Sec.3: Body

Join Front and Back Bodies and Work in the round

Continue Chart, Front Center Increases and Sides Decreases (every 4 rows / on R1,R5 and R9 of Chart)

R1: K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, K to Mil, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to End, PMs,
Place 81 Back Yoke sts on a needle, K to End, PMM, Join to work in the round
>Start with R7 of Chart R/L, 89sts for Front Body, 81sts for Back Body, 170sts in total
R2: SMM, K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, K to Mil, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to MM (Slipping Ms)
R3: SMM, K1, SSK, K to Mor, SMor, Chart R, SMir, M1L, K to Mil, M1R, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to 3sts bef Ms, K2to, K to MM (Slipping Ms)
>27sts between Mir and Mil, 21sts between MM/Ms and Mor/Mol
R4-6: R2
R7-34: [R3-6] 7 times
>41sts between Mir and Mil, 14sts between MM/Ms and Mor/Mol
R35: R3
>43sts between Mir and Mil, 13sts between MM/Ms and Mor/Mol
R36: R2

Start German Short Row (Back Hem Shaping)

SR1(RS): K to Mor, Turn
SR2(WS): MDS, P to Mol (Slipping MM and Ms), Turn
SR3(RS): MDS, K to 3sts bef DS (Slipping Ms and MM), Turn
SR4(WS): MDS, P to 3sts bef DS (Slipping MM and Ms), Turn
SR5-8: [SR3-4] 2 times
SR9(RS): MDS, K to MM (Slipping Ms)

End German Short Row, and Continue Chart

R37: SMM, K to Mor (Knitting DS), SMor, Chart R, SMir, K to Mil, SMil, Chart L, SMol, K to Ms (Knitting DS), SMs, K to MM
>End with R7 of Chart R/L

Sec.4: Hem

Change to 5.1mm/JP10 circular needle

Separate Back and Front Hems and Work Front Hem in flat

R1(RS): [K1, P1] to 1st bef Mor, K1, RMor, P1, K1, P1, K2, PM, K2, P1, K1, P1, RMir, [K1, P1] to 1st bef Mil, K1, RMil, P1, K1, P1, K2,
Place next 117 Back Hem sts to M on a holder, RM
>53sts for Front Hem
R2(WS): P2, [K1, P1] to 1sts bef End, P1
R3(RS): K2, [P1, K1] to 1sts bef End, K1
R4-17: [R2-3] 7 times
R18(WS): BO all sts in pattern

Join Yarn and Work Back Hem in flat

R1(WS): Place 117 Back Hem sts on a needle with WS facing, Sl18, RMM, Join yarn, [K1, P1] to 1st bef End (Removing Ms and Mol), P1
R2(RS): K2, [P1, K1] to 1st bef End, K1
R3(WS): P2, [K1, P1] to 1st bef End, P1
R4-17 [R2-3] 7 times
R18(RS): R2

R19(WS): BO all sts in pattern

Sec.5: Sleeves

Use **6.0mm/JP13** circular needle

Join Yarn and Work Sleeve in the round

R1: Join Yarn, Pick up and knit 23sts starting at the bottom of the armhole, Place 1 Sleeve st on the needle and knit,
Pick up and knit 22sts, PM for BOR
>approximately pick up 2sts per 3rows, 46sts in total

R2: P1, K to M

R3-8: R2

Start Sleeve Decreases (every 8 rows)

R9: P1, SSK, K to 2sts bef M, K2to
>2sts dec, 44sts in total

R10-65: [R2-9] 7 times
>14ssts dec, 30sts in total

R66: R2

Sec.6: Cuffs

Change to **5.1mm/JP10** circular needle

R1: [P1, K1] to M

R2-17: R1

R18: BO all sts in pattern
