Hatsuyukikazura



Hatsuyukikazura is inspired by the plant of the same name, known for the beautiful pink and white variegated spots on its new leaves.

This pullover is worked flat from the cuff to the center of the body.

The left and right halves are joined at the center, then stitches are picked up along the bottom edge to work the hem.

YARN

TréLiz Zeus - Fingering - 100% Superwash Merino Single
[100g / 366m / 100% Wool]
col.Guerrilla Girl approximately 350g / 1281m

NEEDLES

3.0mm / JP3 circular needle

Crochet hook (for provisional crochet cast on)

Cable needle

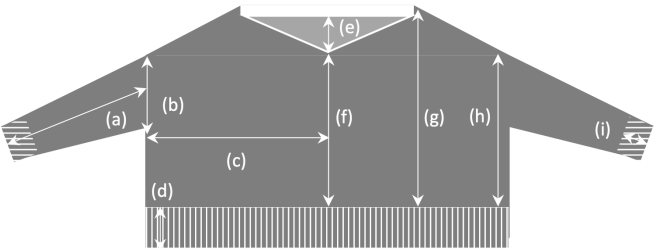
GAUGE

27 sts and 37 rows = 10cm
In Stockinette stitch with 3.0mm / JP3 needle

NOTIONS

- Stitch markers
- Holders
- Waste yarn (for provisional crochet cast on)
- Tapestry needle

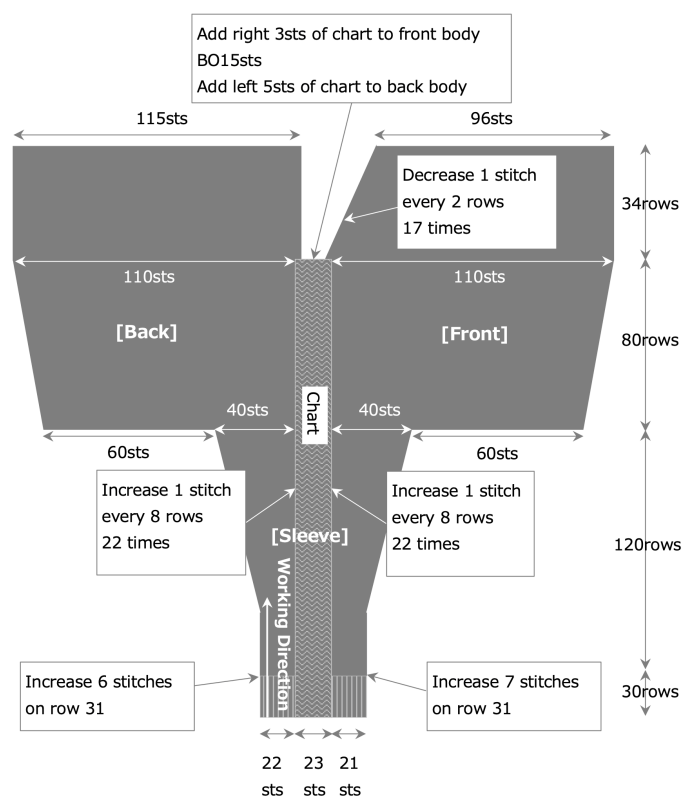

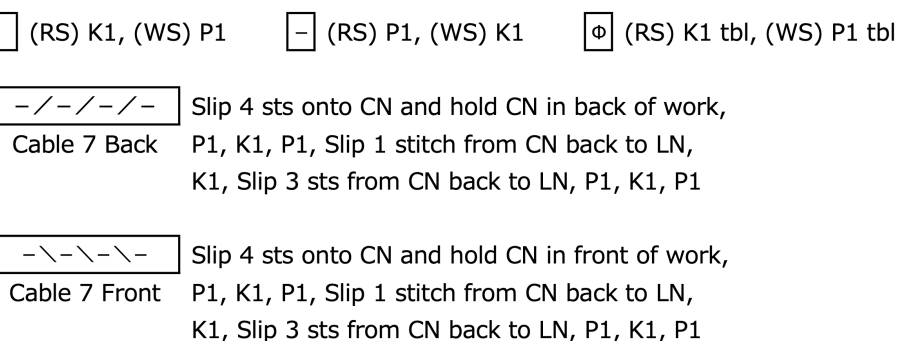

INSTRUCTION FOR RIGHT BODY



Left body is symmetric from where front and back bodies are separated

1set; 23sts and 8rows Mc (for marking center of chart)



R1(RS): CO66 using Long Tail cast on method

R2(WS): [K1, P1 tbl] 11 times, PM, [K1, P1] 5 times, K1, PMc, P1 tbl, [K1, P1] 5 times, K1, PM, [P1 tbl, K1] 10 times, K1

R4(WS): [K1, P1 tbl] to M, SM, [K1, P1] to 1 st bef Mc, K1, SMc, P1 tbl, [K1, P1] to 1 st bef M, K1, SM, [P1 tbl, K1] to 1 st bef End, K1

Start Chart

> Start with R1 of Chart

R9-30: [R7-8] 11 times

SEC. 2: SLEEVE

Continue @ [Chart](#) and Start Sleeve in Reverse Stockinette St

R1(RS): [P3, M1PR] 7 times, SM, Chart, SM, [M1PL, P3] 6 times, P4

> Start with R1 of Chart, 13 sts inc, 79 sts in total, 28 sts between each End and M

R2(WS): K to M, SM, Chart, SM, K to End

R3(RS): P to M, SM, Chart, SM, P to End

R4-23: [R2-3] 10 times

R24(WS): R2

> End with R8 of Chart, 3 sets of chart inc, 6 sets of chart in total

Continue @ [Chart](#) and Start Increases (every 8 rows)

R25(RS): P to M, M1PR, SM, Chart, SM, M1PL, P to End

> Start with R1 of Chart, 2 sts inc, 81 sts in total, 29 sts between each End and M

R26-31: [R2-3] 3 times

R32(WS): R2

> End with R8 of Chart, 1 set of chart inc, 7 sets of chart in total

R33-120: [R25-32] 11 times

> End with R8 of Chart, 11 sets of chart inc, 18 sets of chart in total, 22 sts inc, 103 sts in total, 40 sts between each End and M

SEC. 3: BODY

Continue @ [Chart](#) and Increases (every 8 rows) and Provisional Crochet Cast On for Front Body and Back Body (See @ [Instruction](#))

R1(RS): P to M, M1PR, SM, Chart, SM, M1PL, P to End, CO60 using Provisional Crochet cast on method

> Start with R1 of Chart, 62 sts inc, 165 sts in total

R2(WS): K to M, SM, Chart, SM, K to End, CO60 using Provisional Crochet cast on method

> 60 sts inc, 225 sts in total, 101 sts between each End and M

R3(RS): P to M, SM, Chart, SM, P to End

R4(WS): K to M, SM, Chart, SM, K to End

R5-8: [R3-4] 2 times

> End with R8 of Chart, 1 set of chart inc, 19 sets of chart in total

Continue @ [Chart](#) and Increases (every 8 rows)

R9(RS): P to M, M1PR, SM, Chart, SM, M1PL, P to End

> Start with R1 of Chart, 2 sts inc, 227 sts in total, 102 sts between each End and M

R10(WS): R4

R11-16: [R3-4] 3 times

> End with R8 of Chart, 1 set of chart inc, 20 sets of chart in total

R17-80: [R9-16] 8 times

> End with R8 of Chart, 8 sets of chart inc, 28 sets of chart in total, 16 sts inc, 243 sts in total, 110 sts between each End and M

Sec.1 to 3 are common to Right Body and Left Body

SEC.4: RIGHT BODY

Separate Front and Back Bodies and Start Front Neck Decreases (every 2 rows)

R1(RS): P to M, RM, K2tog, K1, Place 130 sts for Back Body on a holder

> 1 st dec, 112 sts in total

R2(WS): P2, K to End

R3(RS): P to 3 sts bef End, K2tog, K1

> 1 st dec, 111 sts in total

R4-33: [R2-3] 15 times

R34(WS): R2

> 15 sts dec, 96 sts in total

Break Yarn and Place 96 sts for Front Body on a holder

Join Yarn and Start Back Body

R1(RS): Place 130 sts for Back Body on a needle, Join yarn, BO15 knitwise, P1, K1, Sl1 wyif, K1, P1, RM, P to End

> 115 sts in total

R2(WS): K to 4 sts bef End, Sl1 wyif, K1, Sl1 wyif, K1

R3(RS): Sl1 wyif, K1, Sl1 wyif, K1, P to End

R4-33: [R2-3] 15 times

R34(WS): R2

If possible, don't break yarn, as it will be used later to join Left and Right Bodies

Place 115 sts on a holder

SEC.5: LEFT BODY

Separate Front and Back Bodies and Start Back Body

R1(RS): P to M, RM, P1, K1, Sl1 wyif, K1, Sl1 wyif, Place 128 sts for Front Body on a holder

> 115 sts in total

R2(WS): K1, Sl1 wyif, K1, Sl1 wyif, K to End

R3(RS): P to 4 sts bef End, K1, Sl1 wyif, K1, Sl1 wyif

R4-33: [R2-3] 15 times

R34(WS): R2

Break Yarn and Place 115 sts for Back Body on a holder

Join Yarn and Start Front Neck Decreases (every 2 rows)

R1(RS): Place 128 sts for Front Body on a needle, Join yarn, BO15 knitwise, K1, SSK, RM, P to End

> 1 st dec, 112 sts in total

R2(WS): K to 2 sts bef End, P2

R3(RS): K1, SSK, P to End

> 1 st dec, 111 sts in total

R4-33: [R2-3] 15 times

R34(WS): R2

> 15 sts dec, 96 sts in total

Don't Break Yarn and Continue to Sec.6

SEC.6: JOIN

Join Left and Right **Front Bodies** using **I-cord Join** method

Place 96 sts for Left Front Body on LN with RS facing, CO3 using Knitted cast on method

> 99 sts in total on LN

Place 96 sts for Right Front Body on RN with RS facing

[Slip 1 stitch from RN onto LN, K2tog, K1, SSK, Slip 3 stitches from RN onto LN] until 3 sts remain

BO all stitches knitwise

Join Left and Right **Back Bodies** using **I-cord Join** method

If necessary, join yarn

Place 115 sts for Right Back Body on LN with RS facing, CO3 using Knitted cast on method

> 118 sts in total on LN

Place 115 sts for Left Back Body on RN with RS facing

[Slip 1 stitch from RN onto LN, K2tog, K1, SSK, Slip 3 stitches from RN onto LN] until 3 sts remain

BO all stitches knitwise

Seam Under Sleeves using **tapestry needle** with **RS facing**

Seam Body Sides using **Three-needle Bind-off** method with **WS facing**

SEC.7: HEM

Join Yarn and Work **in the round**

R1: Join yarn, pick up and knit 348 sts from the left side seam, PM for BOR, join to work in the round

> approximately pick up 3 sts per 4 rows

R2: SM, [P2, K1 tbl] to M

R3-32: R2

BO all stitches purlwise
