col.101 1148m / 700g

NEEDLES

4.5mm/JP8 circular needle
4.2mm/JP7 circular needle

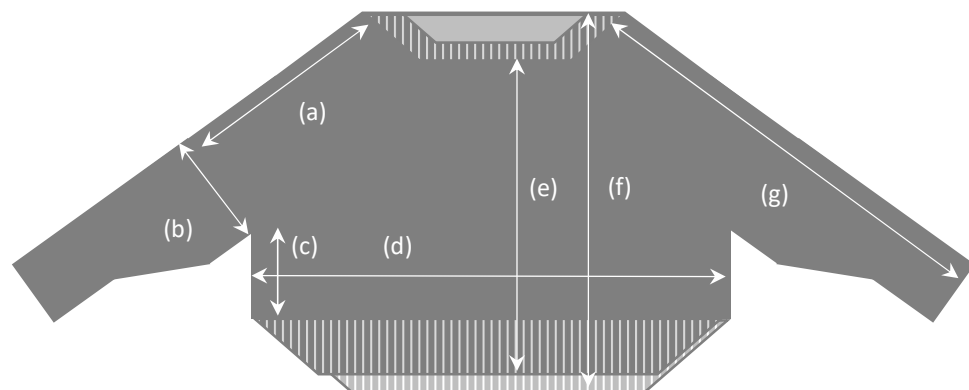
GAUGE

25sts and 22rows = 10cm
In Chart A (See Page 3) with 4.5mm/JP8 needle

NOTIONS

Stitch markers
Holders
Cable Needle
Crochet hook (for provisional croshet cast on)
Scrap yarn (for provisional croshet cast on)

b: 17cm d: 60cm f: 58cm

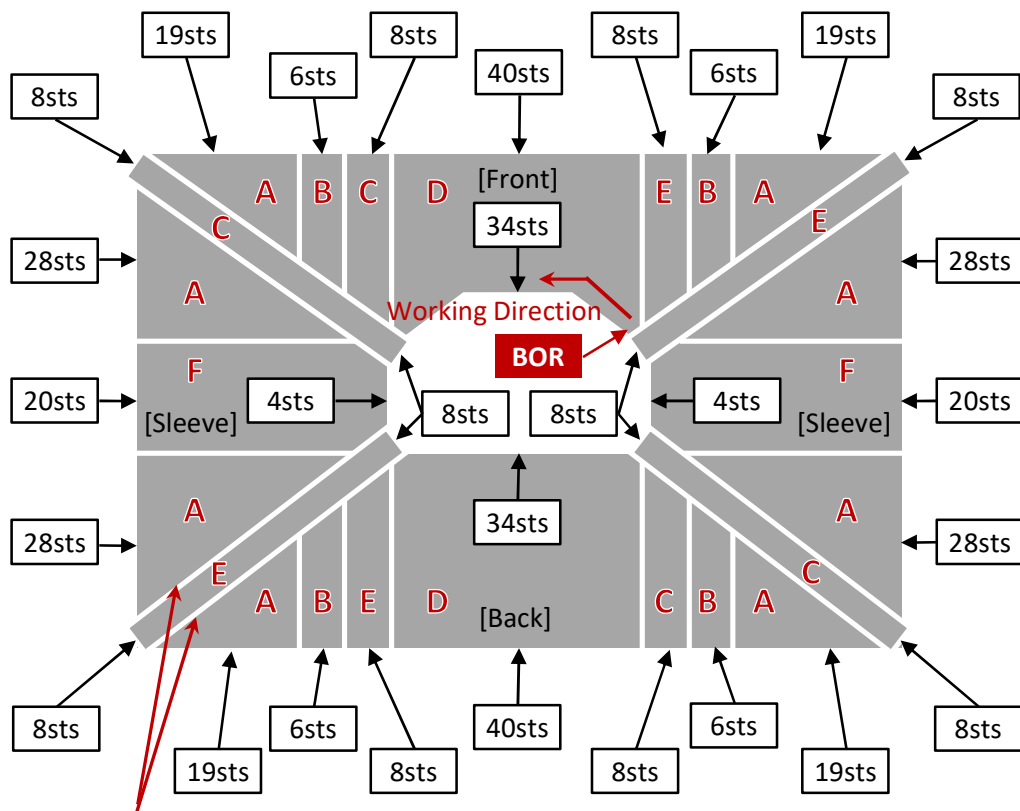
Finished body circumference approximately 120cm

2/2 LT Purl: Sl2 to cable needle hold in front, P2, K2 from cable needle
2/2 LT W: Sl2 to cable needle hold in front, P2, P2 from cable needle
4/4 RT: Sl4 to cable needle hold in back, K4, K4 from cable needle
4/4 LT: Sl4 to cable needle hold in front, K4, K4 from cable needle
3/3 RT: Sl3 to cable needle hold in back, K3, K3 from cable needle
3/3 LT: Sl3 to cable needle hold in front, K3, K3 from cable needle
Pfb: Purl into front and back of stitch
S2PP: Sl2, P1, Pass slipped stitches over
from R to L: from right to left
from L to R: from left to right

INSTRUCTION FOR YOKE



Increase 3 sts every 4 rows on every raglan line

- Chart A:** One pattern repeat = 2 sts × 1 row
See  Center Yoke (L) on page 4 of Chart
- Chart B:** One pattern repeat = 6 sts × 2 row
See  Center Yoke (R) on page 3 of Chart
- Chart C:** One pattern repeat = 8 sts × 4 row
See  Side Yoke (R) on page 5 of Chart
- Chart D:** One pattern repeat = 40 sts × 36 row
See  Center Body (L) on page 8 of Chart
- Chart E:** One pattern repeat = 8 sts × 4 row
See  Side Yoke (L) on page 6 of Chart
- Chart F:** One pattern repeat = 20 sts × 36 row
See  Sleeve (L) on page 15 of Chart

Sec.1: Yoke

Use **4.5mm/JP8** circular needle and **Work Yoke in the round**

CO108 using Crocheted Provisional Cast On,
PM for BOR, Join to work in the round
>BOR is at the right of Front Yoke

Start **Chart Yoke SR (See Chart page 1-2)**

R1: SM, Work R1 from R to L, following Front Yoke SR (K34),
Side Yoke SR (K20), Back Yoke SR (K34), and
Side Yoke SR (K20) charts in order
> It may be helpful to place a marker between each chart

Start **German Short Rows** for shaping the front neckline

SR1(RS): SM, Work right-side R2 of Front Yoke SR from R to L, Turn
SR2:(WS) Work right-side R3 of Front York SR from L to R, SM,
Work R2 from L to R, following Side Yoke SR,
Back Yoke SR and Side Yoke SR charts in order,
Work left-side R2 of Front York SR from L to R, Turn
SR3(RS): Work left-side R3 of Front York SR from R to L,
Work R3 from R to L, following Side Yoke SR,
Back Yoke SR and Side Yoke SR charts in order, SM,
Work right-side R4 of Front York SR from R to L, Turn
SR4-18: Continue as for SR2-3, following the charts
SR19(RS): Work left-side R19 of Front York SR from R to L,
Work R19 from R to L, following Side Yoke SR,
Back Yoke SR and Side Yoke SR charts in order

End German Short Rows

R20: SM, Work R20 from R to L, following Front Yoke SR,
Side Yoke SR, Back Yoke SR, and Side Yoke SR charts in order
> 48 sts for each Side, 62 sts for Front and Back, 220 sts total

Start **Chart Yoke (See Chart page 3-6)**

R21-50: SM, Work charts Center Yoke (R)-(L), Side Yoke (R)-(L)
in order twice
> 92 sts for each Side, 106 sts for Front and Back, 396 sts total

Sec.2: Body

Separate Sleeves and Body

Start **Chart Body (See Chart page 7-10)**

R1: SM, Work R1 of Center Body (R)-(L),
Work R1 of Left Body chart sts 1-34,
Place 76 sts for the sleeve on a holder,
CO17 using Loop Cast-On,
Work R1 of Left Body chart sts 52-59,
Work R1 of Center Body (R)-(L),
Work R1 of Right Body chart sts 1-34,
Place 76 sts for the sleeve on a holder,
CO17 using Loop Cast-On,
Work R1 of right Body chart sts 52-59,
> 282 sts total

R2-50: SM, Work the next row, following Center Body (R)-(L),
Left Body, Center Body (R)-(L), Right Body charts in order

Sec.3: Front Hem

Work Front Hem flat

Start Chart Front Hem (See Chart page 11)

R1(RS): RM, Work R1 of Front Hem (R)-(L) chart sts 6-142,
Place 142 sts for Back Hem on a holder, Turn

> 142 sts total

R2-18: Work the next row of Front Hem (R)-(L), Turn

> 110 sts total

BO all stitches **in Front Hem (R)-(L) pattern**

Sec.4: Back Hem

Use 4.5mm/JP8 circular needle

Work Back Hem flat

Start Chart Back Hem (See Chart page 12-13)

R1(RS): Join yarn at the left side of Body,
Work R1 of Back Hem (R)-(L), Turn

R2-26: Work the next row of Back Hem (R)-(L)", Turn

> 94 sts total

BO all stitches **in Back Hem (R)-(L) pattern**

Sec.5: Sleeves

Use 4.5mm/JP8 circular needle

Work Sleeve in the round

Start Chart Sleeve (See Chart page 14-15)

R1: Join yarn at the center of the underarm,
Pick up and knit 10 sts from the underarm,
Place 76 sleeve sts on the left-hand needle and
work R1 of Sleeve (R)-(L) chart sts 11-86,
Pick up and knit 9 sts from the underarm,
PM for BOR, Join to work in the round

> 95 sts total

R2-50: Work the next row of Sleeve (R)-(L)

> 77 sts total

Sec.6: Cuffs

Work Cuff in the round

Start Chart Cuff (See Chart page 16)

R1-46: Work R1-46 of Cuff

> 53 sts total

BO all stitches **in Cuff pattern**

Sec.7: Neck

Use 4.2mm/JP7 circular needle

Work Neck in the round

Remove the Crocheted Provisional Cast On from Sec.1 and
Place the 108 sts on the needle, Join to work in the round,
Slip stitches until the center of the back, PM for BOR, Join yarn

R1-2: SM, K to M

R3-15: SM, [K1 tbl, P1] to M

BO all stitches knitwise

Fold the neck in half to the wrong side and sew in place
