



Shidarezakura has a brioche pattern that looks like weeping cherry trees.  
It is worked top-down seamlessly.

## YARN

Keito-Zakka Stores Colline [40g/160m/75%wool,25%nylon]  
MC;  
col.9 Straight Gray approximately 200g/800m  
CC;  
col.10 Dusty Pink approximately 130g/520m

## NEEDLES

3.3mm/JP4 circular needle  
3.0mm/JP3 circular needle

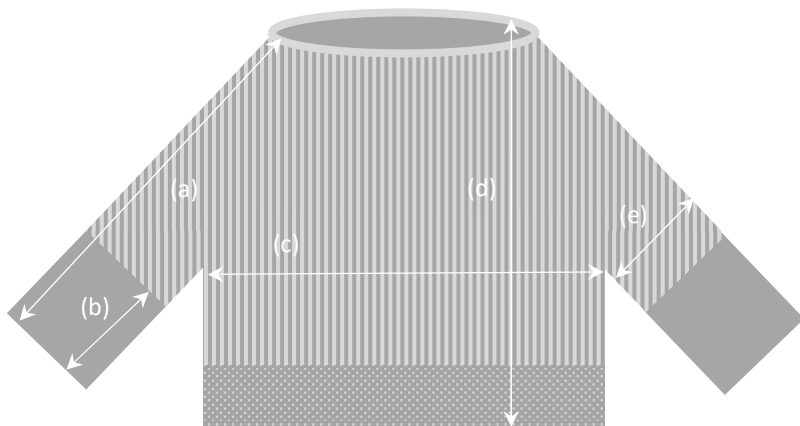
## GAUGE

21sts and 40rows = 10cm  
In Garter stitch with 3.3mm/JP4 needle

## NOTIONS

Stitch markers  
Holders

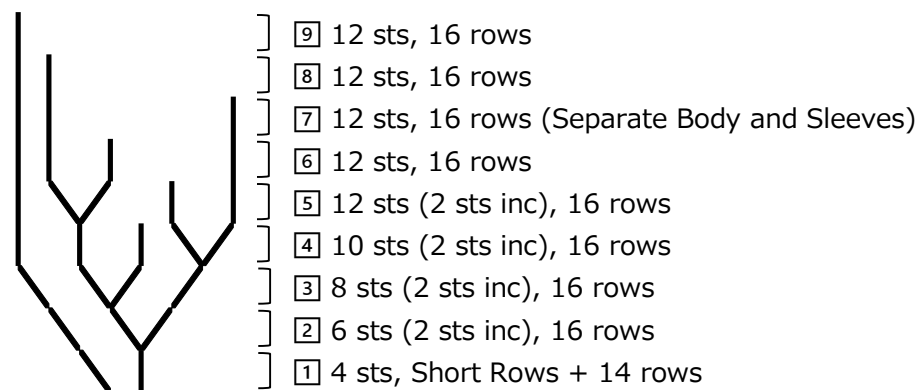

## BRIOCHE PATTERN INSTRUCTION



11 sets each for front and back, 6 sets each for sleeves, 34 sets in total

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## Sec.1: Neck

Use **3.0mm/JP3** circular needle and **CC**

R1: **CO130**, PM for BOR, Join to work in the round  
> BOR is at the back of the right sleeve  
R2-5: SM, [P1, K1 tbl] to M  
R6: SM, P to M

## Sec.2: Yoke

Change to **3.3mm/JP4** circular needle

Start **Brioche Pattern 1** (See page2)

Set Up: SM, [K20, Kfb, K21, Kfb, K21, Kfb] 2 times  
>6 sts inc, 136 sts in total

Start **German Short Row**

SR1(RS): SM, K1, turn  
SR2(WS): MDS, SM, [Sl1yo, K1] 22 times, Turn  
SR3(RS): MDS, [Brk1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef M, Brk1, SM, PDS,  
[Sl1yo, P1] 3 times, Turn  
SR4(WS): MDS, [Brp1, Sl1yo] to M, SM, [Sl1yo, Brk1] to 1 st bef DS,  
Sl1yo, KDS, [Sl1yo,K1] 3 times, Turn  
SR5(RS): MDS, [Brk1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef M, Brk1, SM,  
[Brp1, Sl1yo] to DS, PDS, [Sl1yo, P1] 3 times, Turn  
SR6-9: [R4-5] 2 times  
SR10(WS): R4  
SR11(RS): MDS, [Brk1, Sl1yo] to 1 st bef M, Brk1, SM,  
[Brp1, Sl1yo] to DS, PDS, [Sl1yo, P1] to 1 st bef DS,  
Sl1yo, PDS, [Sl1yo, Brp1] to 1 st bef M, Sl1yo

Join **MC** and Start **Color Work**

R1(CC): SM, [Sl1yo, Brk1] to M  
R2(MC): SM, [Brp1, Sl1yo] to M  
R3-14: [R1-2] 6 times

Start **Brioche Pattern 2**

R15(CC): SM, [Sl1yo, Brkyobr, Sl1yo, Brk1] to M  
> 68 sts inc, 204 sts in total  
R16(MC): SM, [Brp1, Sl1yo, P1, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo] to M  
R17-30: [R1-2] 7 times

Start **Brioche Pattern 3**

R31(CC): SM, [Sl1yo, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brkyobr, Sl1yo, Brk1] to M  
> 68 sts inc, 272 sts in total  
R32(MC): SM, [[Brp1,Sl1yo] 2 times, P1, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo] to M  
R33-46: [R1-2] 7 times

Start **Brioche Pattern 4**

R47(CC): SM, [Sl1yo, Brkyobr, [Sl1yo, Brk1] 3 times] to M  
> 68 sts inc, 340 sts in total  
R48(MC): SM, [Brp1, Sl1yo, P1, [Sl1yo, Brp1] 3 times, Sl1yo] to M  
R49-62: [R1-2] 7 times

Start **Brioche Pattern 5**

R63(CC): SM, [[Sl1yo, Brk1] 2 times, K1, Brk1, K1, Brkyobr, Sl1yo, Brk1]  
to M  
> 68 sts inc, 408 sts in total

R64(MC): SM, [[Brp1, Sl1yo] 2 times, P3, Sl1yo, P1, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo]  
to M  
R65(CC): SM, [[Sl1yo, Brk1] 2 times, K3, [Brk1, Sl1yo] 2 times, Brk1]  
to M  
R66(MC): SM, [[Brp1, Sl1yo] 2 times, P3, [Sl1yo, Brp1] 2 times, Sl1yo]  
to M  
R67-78: [R65-66] 6 times

### Separate Sleeves and Body

#### Start Brioche Pattern [7]

R1(CC): SM, [Place 72 sleeve stitches on a holder, CO12,  
[Sl1yo, Brk1, K5, Brk1, K1, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] 11 times]  
to M  
> 288 sts in total  
R2(MC): SM, [P1, Sl1yo, P7, Sl1yo, P1, Sl1yo,  
[BrP1, Sl1yo, P7, Sl1yo, BrP1, Sl1yo] 11 times] to M  
R3(CC): SM, [Sl1yo, Brk1, K7, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to M  
R4(MC): SM, [Brp1, Sl1yo, P7, Sl1yo, BrP1, Sl1yo] to M  
R5-16: [R3-4] 6 times

#### Start Brioche Pattern [8]

R17(CC): SM, [K1, Brk1, K7, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to M  
R18(MC): SM, [P9, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo] to M  
R19(CC): SM, [K9, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to M  
R20-31: [R18-19] 6 times  
R32(MC): R18

#### Start Brioche Pattern [9]

R33(CC): SM, [K9, Brk1, K1, Brk1] to M  
R34(MC): SM, [P11, Sl1yo] to M  
R35(CC): SM, [K11, Brk1] to M  
R36-47: [R34-35] 6 times  
R48(MC): R34

#### End Brioche Pattern

R49(CC): SM, [K11, Brk1] to M  
R50(MC): SM, P to M  
R51(CC): SM, K to M  
R52-93: [R50-51] 21 times

## Sec.4: Hem

R1: SM, P to M  
R2-4: SM, K to M  
R5-7: SM, P to M  
R8-15: SM, K to M  
R16: BO knitwise

## Sec.5: Sleeves

**Use 3.3mm/JP4 circular needle and CC**

**Start Brioche Pattern 7 (except 12 sts of the underarm)**

R1(CC): Begin at the center of the underarm,  
Pick up and knit 6sts from the underarm,  
Place 72 sleeve stitches on the left needle from a holder,  
K1, Brk1, K5, Brk1, K1, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1,  
[Sl1yo, Brk1, K5, Brk1, K1, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to End,  
Pick up and knit 6sts from the underarm,  
PM for BOR, Join to work in the round

> 84 sts in total

**Join MC**

R2(MC): SM, P7, Sl1yo, P7, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo,  
[Brp1, Sl1yo, P7, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo] to 6 sts bef M, P6  
R3(CC): SM, K7, Brk1, K7, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1,  
[Sl1yo, Brk1, K7, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to 6 sts bef M, K6  
R4-15: [R2-3] 6 times  
R16(MC): R2

**Start Brioche Pattern 8 (except 12 sts of the underarm)**

R17(CC): SM, K6, [K1, Brk1, K7, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to 6 sts bef M, K6  
R18(MC): SM, P6, [P9, Sl1yo, Brp1, Sl1yo] to 6 sts bef M, P6  
R19(CC): SM, K6, [K9, Brk1, Sl1yo, Brk1] to 6 sts bef M, K6  
R20-31: [R18-19] 6 times  
R32(MC): R18

**Start Brioche Pattern 9 (except 12 sts of the underarm)**

R33(CC): SM, K6, [K9, Brk1, K1, Brk1] to 6 sts bef M, K6  
R34(MC): SM, P6, [P11, Sl1yo] to 6 sts bef M, P6  
R35(CC): SM, K6, [K11, Brk1] to 6 sts bef M, K6  
R36-47: [R34-35] 6 times  
R48(MC): R34

**End Brioche Pattern and Break CC**

R49: SM, K6, [K11, Brk1] to 6 sts bef M, K6  
R50: SM, GS to M  
R51: SM, K to M  
R52: SM, [K1, P1] to M  
R53: SM, [P1, K1] to M  
R54-107: [R52-53] 27 times

## Sec.6: Cuffs

**Use 3.0mm/JP3 circular needle**

R1: SM, K to M  
R2: SM, P to M  
R3: SM, K to M  
R4-9: SM, [P1, K1 tbl] to M  
R10: BO in R9 pattern
